Brief Curriculum Vitae of Mr. Ioannis Margaris:

Ioannis Margaris is Electrical and Computer Engineer (N.T.U.A., 2006) and has concluded his PhD in the Electric Energy System Laboratory of N.T.U.A. School of Electrical and Computer Engineering in 2011. During his PhD research, he dealt specifically with the analysis, modelling and monitoring of Electricity and Renewable Energy Sources Systems in numerous international, European and Greek research programmes. Within the same period, he was working for a specific period of time in Public Power Corporation (PPC) in the Department of Islands Management on issues relative to the dynamic system safety and data management for Smart Grids and Microgrids applications in the Greek islands system. Afterwards, he concluded his Post-Doc research in the Technical University of Denmark (DTU Wind Energy Department 2012) where he worked for a year (2013) as Researcher (equivalent to Assistant Professor) and coordinator in Research and Development Programmes in North Europe, giving lectures in post graduate courses of DTU.

Since 2013, he cooperates with the N.T.U.A. Electric Energy System Laboratory as scientific collaborator and is founding member of the Collaborative Design CPD Group with emphasis in public areas and infrastructure. He has participated in many international scientific conferences with publications in more than 30 international magazines, papers, conferences and electronic media on issues relative to energy and technology policy, issues of wider productive reconstruction in Greece and abroad, innovation and management of environmental infrastructure.

In 2014, he participated in FLOK Project in Ecuador, an international project of productive reconstruction and open knowledge.

He was born in 1951 and he is Electrical Engineer, graduate of the School of Electrical Engineering in the University of Patras. He has Master Degree from Kingston University in Business Administration (MBA) with specialization in Strategic Management. Today, he continues his studies in the School of Political Sciences of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.

He started his professional career as researcher in the Technical Company "K.B. KONSTANTOPOULOS & Co" General Partnership.

Afterwards, he worked as Director of Supplies for VIAMAX S.A. (Mercedes-Benz) and for Mr. Fostiropoulos' whole industrial group in Greece.

From 1981 and until 2011, he worked in PPC's Distribution Sector as:

- Head of the Technical Sector in Kilkis Region (1981-1983).
- Director of Kilkis Region (1983-1996).
- Director of Eastern Thessaloniki Region (1996-2011).



In parallel with his duties as Director of Kilgis Region, he was assigned with the duties of Operational Planning Coordinator in the Department of Macedonia-Thrace Region (1988-1990) and participated in the Working Groups of PPC's Reconstruction Programme under the name of "THALES" with the French Corporation E.D.F. as Consultant. The Region's Decentralized Computer Monitoring of Expenses constitutes one of the results of his work in this project.

During his service, he gained moral awards for the performance of Kilgis and Eastern Thessaloniki Regions.

He developed syndicalist activity in the Engineering field and was member of the Prefectural Committee of the Technical Chamber of Greece in Kilgis Prefecture for nine years.

In local authority level, he served as Vice-Mayor in Social Services and president in the Cultural Organization of Kilgis Municipality for three consecutive four-year periods. (1998-2010).
