HEDNO: An electric vehicle charging station was inaugurated in Lavrio

At an event organized by the Municipality of Lavreotiki, the first electric vehicle charging station in Southeastern Attica was inaugurated today at Iron Square in Lavrio in the presence of HEDNO's Chairman and CEO, Mr. N. Chatziargyriou, and the Mayor of Lavreotiki, Mr. D. Loukas.

The new station is the result of HEDNO's constructive collaboration with the National Technical University of Athens, in particular with the SmartRue research team of the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering, within the framework of the European research program known as SHAR-Q.

During the inauguration, Mr. N. Chatziargyriou extended his warm thanks to the Mayor, Mr Loukas, for cooperating in the construction of this station, while stressing that the active participation of HEDNO in the development of public charging infrastructure has been decisive for promoting electro-mobility in Greece.

Mr. Loukas, for his part, said: "In the context of implementing the smart city strategy, HEDNO and the National Technical University of Athens have been key strategic partners of our municipality and starting with today's inauguration of the electric vehicle charging station here in Lavrio, we wish to warmly thank HEDNO and inform you that we are pursuing similar energy-saving actions to make our cities friendlier to our citizens. May I also add that our municipality participates in the European Covenant of Mayors for the exploitation of renewable energy sources while saving natural resources."

Mr. K. Andreadis, HEDNO's Director of the Network Directorate Measurement Department stressed that the active participation of HEDNO in projects promoting new, more environmentally-friendly technologies is a key component of its strategy. All efforts converge to a key goal, which is to modernize networks and to usher them in the era of smart grids.
