Update on the response to the damages caused by the snowstorm "ELPIDA"

HEDNO continues to release updates for the public regarding the progress of the restoration of the damages caused to the Electricity Distribution Network by the snowstorm "ELPIDA" and would like to note that all forces continue to work intensively, with the aim to restore electricity supply in all areas.

More specifically, as regards faults per area:

In Attica, faults are being restored in 15 lines. There are individual electricity supply problems at a neighborhood level in the following areas: Agia Paraskevi, Papagos, Holargos, Marousi and Chalandri. As before, there are more extensive problems in Eastern Attica and more specifically in the areas of Nea Makri, Pikermi, Grammatiko, Kalentzi, Voutsa, Lavrio, Kato Souli, Marathonas, Kalyvia and Keratea, where restoration is more difficult due to the difficult access to the locations where the problem is identified.

As far as the islands are concerned, all the faults have been restored except for some villages in the area of Chania. Accordingly, all the faults in Evia were restored and the electricity supply to the settlements of Atalanti is expected to be restored until later this evening.

Therefore, and taking into account all the above information, from yesterday until this hour, the electricity supply has already been restored in 80% of the areas that were facing a problem due to faults.



It should be noted that there will be a new update on the progress of the restoration of the faults and the electricity supply to the areas at 11 pm, tracking the progress of the works which are expected to almost fully restore the Medium Voltage network.
