

Press Release Safety instructions for kite flying

The Hellenic Electricity Distribution Network Operator (HEDNO) advises that you not fly your kite near power lines, due to severe risk of electric shock and outages in the area.

For your safety, if your kite gets caught in a power line, please:

- 1. do not attempt to retrieve it by pulling the string or by using other objects, including wooden objects
- 2. keep off scaffolding or power distribution and electric lighting poles, including spots near power lines
