Continuous works for the restoration of damages to the Electricity Network in Northern and Eastern Attica.

From the first moment of the outbreak of the catastrophic fire in Penteli, HEDNO crews have been mobilized and continue to work intensively for the restoration of damages to the Network.

More specifically, due to the catastrophic fire, 2 Medium Voltage lines had been out of operation in the area since last night; this morning, 4 Medium Voltage lines were out of operation. They supply 210 sub-stations and affect around 15,000 consumers.

Moreover, according to the information so far, about 100 Medium and Low Voltage poles must be immediately replaced and 5 Medium Voltage Substations must be rebuilt due to total destruction.

However, thanks to the immediate mobilization of HEDNO's crews, the electricity supply was restored to 90 substations until noon today, enabling the restoration of electricity for 6,700 consumers.

According to the Network inspections so far, it is estimated that electricity will be restored in about 90 additional substations, at locations where HEDNO crews have access and provided that no new damages will occur.

More than 300 technical staff members have been deployed locally (HEDNO crews and partner contractors) with 120 vehicles and machinery and work non-stop at all network locations that can be accessed, as until this hour firefighters continue their efforts.

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
