HEDNO announcement on the progress of electricity restoration and repairs

Following Barbara storm which is sweeping through Greece from Sunday morning (5 February 2023), HEDNO announces that our crews have been fully prepared and alert from the outbreak of the phenomenon. Our staff continues to remain alert throughout the progress of the storm and will immediately proceed with interventions at all points which have been affected and deal with electricity supply problems.

During the day, the storm affected power supplies in Attica and in parts of the following areas: Ippokrateios Politeia, Afidnes, Dionysos, Drosia, Grammatiko and part of the Varnava settlement. In Evoia, at the comnuities of Seta, Fylla and Afratio, as well as 8 villages at the mountainous area of Psachna. Finally, at Sporades in parts of Skiathos, Skopelos and Alonnisos.

From the 30, in total, damages at Medium Voltage lines that took place in the morning, 22 have been restored, and HEDNO crews are currently continuing works for the restoration of 8 Medium Voltage lines which are affecting the following areas in Attica: Grammatiko, Kalentzi, Marathonas, Vilia, Oinoe and Aspropirgos, in the areas of Dirfyes and Nileos in Evoia, a small part in Skopelos and the area of Lakereia in Larissa.

Please note that more than 800 technicians (HEDNO staff and partner contractors) are currently operating or remain alert in Attica and more than 150 technicians (HEDNO staff and partner contractors) in Evoia, with all equipment required for these conditions, such as: special project machinery, snowtracks, generators etc. while special branch-works crews remain prepared to deal with any falls of trees on the Network.
