

ANNOUNCEMENT

HEDNO would like to announce that after hard work carried out by its crews and partner contractors, electricity supply in the peninsula of Kassandra was initiated in the early morning hours.

More specifically, HEDNO proceeded with supplying the Kassandreia Substation via Medium Voltage lines and the north-eastern part of the Peninsula. After the gradual restoration of damages in the two webs of the IPTO transmission line, HEDNO carried out power supply for the Substation of Kassandreia from the transmission network and initiated supply for all other areas in the Peninsula which is expected to be completed until this evening.

HEDNO Chairman and CEO Mr. Stefanos Oktapodas as well as the Administration would like to warmly thank all employees for their truly challenging and arduous, hard work across the areas in northern Greece hit by the storm to react immediately and restore hundreds of damages caused in the Electricity Distribution Network speedily and effectively. We would like to particularly thank all employees in the Prefecture of Halkidiki for all their efforts, since they checked and restored extended damages in a 2.429 km Medium Voltage Network and a 2.152 km Low Voltage Network that supply 162 Medium Voltage customers and 153.382 Low Voltage customers respectively.

Finally, HEDNO would like to once more express its deepest condolences to the families of the victims.
