## Most of the damages caused by the bad weather in many areas across the country have been restored

HEDNO would like to announce that thanks to the prompt response of its crews, most of the damages caused by the bad weather in many areas across the country have been restored, from the early morning hours yesterday until today.

More specifically, the adverse weather conditions - stormy winds and heavy rainfall - have caused many damages in many areas of the country and in particular in Eastern Macedonia, Evoia, Sporades, Crete and the Eastern Aegean Sea area.

The readiness and vigilance of HEDNO crews across Greece have resulted in the immediate restoration of most of the damages, even under very adverse conditions, due to both bad weather and the additional difficulties posed by the emergency measures imposed on our country due to the pandemic.

Thanks to the hard work of HEDNO crews, up until now almost all damages in the Medium Voltage Grids have been restored, while a small number of damages are still pending, mainly in the Low Voltage Grid in the Xanthi and Kavala area, which are expected to be restored today.

HEDNO Management would like to address once again their sincere thanks to its employees for their prompt response and their strong sense of duty, especially under the extremely difficult and unprecedented conditions we all currently face.
