



## ANNOUNCEMENT

HEDNO would like to announce that our crews continue the efforts to restore the damages that have affected the Electricity Distribution Network due to Ianos cyclone at all afflicted areas.

More specifically, until this hour, supply has been restored in the city of Zakynthos and the surrounding areas, as well as the northwestern and southeastern part of the island. In Kefalonia and Ithaki, our crews have detected several damages but current conditions still prevent their restoration.

HEDNO crews reacted immediately with adequate resources and equipment at all geographical areas - Western Peloponnese, the Ionian Islands, Central Greece, Evoia and Attica - which have been and are still expected to be afflicted by the phenomenon of Ianos within the next hours, as per the forecasts of the Hellenic National Meteorological Service.

The total number of HEDNO's technical staff and partner contractors that have been alerted since the day before yesterday count a total of 830 persons while 130 special vehicles have been developed for the execution of the works. At the areas that have been afflicted more severely, their further enhancement has been scheduled with extra technical staff for today and tomorrow.

The enhanced units of the Company remain in post at all aforementioned areas in order to ensure that, as soon as access to the Network is possible and safe, damages are restored as quickly as possible. HEDNO's CEO, Mr A. Manos, has visited the afflicted areas and remains there together with the competent executives to ensure the effective coordination of all necessary works.
