



## ANNOUNCEMENT

HEDNO would like to inform all consumers that the progress of the works for the restoration of damages at the Electricity Distribution Network at areas afflicted by cyclone Ianos, is as follows:

In Kefalonia, works are still progressing at the northern part of the island where most electricity problems are taking place, while within the next hours, Skala is expected to be reconnected to the network.

In Ithaki, Vathi has been fully reconnected, while the crews are now focusing on the northern part of the island, which deals with severe difficulties in the access to the parts of the Network that have been afflicted by weather.

In Zakynthos, the areas of Alikes, ALikanas and Volima have been reconnected to the network, while works for the restoration of extended damages are still taking place in the area of Agios Nikolaos.

In the Prefecture of Karditsa, 61 substations in the urban web of the city have been reconnected and within the next hours, we are expecting the reconnection of 10 more, while 2 generating sets (G/S) is also being completed for the coverage of the loads of central points. At the same time, works are rapidly progressing for the reconnection of the villages of Argithea and Mouzaki.

HEDNO Chairman and CEO Mr. A. Mnaos and General Manager of Network Development and Operation Mr I. Menegatos, have just concluded a meeting together with the heads of the Fire Brigade of Karditsa for the coordination and rapid progress of water pumping works at the part of the network that require works by HEDNO crews for quicker electricity reconnection.
