

ANNOUNCEMENT

HEDNO would like to inform all consumers that the progress of the works for the restoration of damages at the Electricity Distribution Network at areas afflicted by cyclone Ianos, is as follows:

In Kefalonia, the pumping station of the Municipality of Lixouri and the villages of Havriata and Loukerata have been reconnected, while we are soon expectin the restoration of supply for part of the village of Anogi, after the restoration of damages at parts where it is possible to have access from the road. At the same time, enhanced HEDNO crews continue their efforts for the reconnection of the wider area of Erissos up to the limits of Fiskardo by gradually removing several trees from the Network.

In Zakinthos, the area of Anafonitria has been reconnected to supply, while works continue in Agios Nikolaos for the next two hours and until later this evening in the areas of Exohora, Maries and Kabi. Wih the restoration of damages at these area, there will only be pending isolated individual damages across the island.

In Ithaki, until this evening, we are expecting the restoration of damages and the reconnection to supply for most villages and settlements, meaning that here too, there will only be pending isolated damages across the island. However, please note that access-related difficulties for the execution of necessary works are still being a problem for the crews of HEDNO in Kioni and Frikes.

In Karditsa, in the city's urban web, 72 out of 114 substations have now been reconnected, and until this evening, the connection of 4 generation sets (G/S) will also be complete for the support of the Network. Mouzaki has been reconnected as well as the area of western Argithea, while at the eastern part and Oxia, the crews are dealing with road access issues. Finally, water pumping works are still continuing in close cooperation with the Fire Brigade in order to enable the reconnection to electricity of all other substations in the area.
