



ANNOUNCEMENT

HEDNO would like to inform all consumers that the progress of the works for the restoration of damages at the Electricity Distribution Network at areas afflicted by cyclone Ianos, as of today, Monday, 21 September, is as follows:

In Kefalonia, the works continue for the reconnection of electricity supply for Agia Afthimia, Assos, Komitata and Fiskardo, since at most parts, the crews are dealing with issues of access due to the large number of trees that have fallen on the Electricity Distribution Network making the progress all the more difficult.

In Zakynthos, the areas of Maries, Exohora, Kabo and Agios Nikolaos have been reconnected, meaning that the entire Medium Voltage Network has been restored. The crews are now focusing on the restoration of isolated, individual damages across various parts of the islands.

In Ithaki, with the reconnection to supply of all the areas at the northern part of the island within the next hours, the works for the restoration of damages on the island are progressing.

In Karditsa, where the works are coordinated by the General Director of Network Development and Operation Mr I. Menegatos, the issue of water pumping remains major and the enhanced crews of HEDNO are striving hard to reconnect all of the city's substations, having managed so far to restore 80 out of 114 substations, while the connection of 4 generating sets (G/S) has been completed.
