



ANNOUNCEMENT

HEDNO would like to inform all consumers that the progress of the works for the restoration of damages at the Electricity Distribution Network at areas afflicted by cyclone Ianos, as of today, Monday, 21 September, is as follows:

In Kefalonia, the pumping stations at Favata in Paliki have been reconnected to supply, while restoration works at Agia Efimia and the northern part up to Fiskardo are still in progress.

In Zakynthos, the works continue for the restoration of isolated damaged at the Low Voltage network.

In Ithaki, works continue at the northern part of the island, where the most serious problems are presented due to the large number of trees that have fallen on the Network, while the area has been reconnected to supply up the village of Lefkes.

In Karditsa, the difficult task of water pumping is still ongoing while the reconnection of 12 substations at the center of the city is still pending, with HEDNO crews having managed to reconnect 102 substations.

The enhanced crews of HEDNO continue their efforts at all areas on 24-hour basis to ensure the quickest possible restoration of the damages at the Electricity Distribution Network.
