

ANNOUNCEMENT

Following the latest announcement regarding the damages that have been caused at the Network due to the Medea weather system, HEDNO would like to announce that a new damage has just been reported at the mainland part of the Network in the area of Pilio which is supplying Sporades, resulting in the disconnection of supply for Skiathos, Skopelos and Alonnisos.

More specifically, bad weather has caused the fall of trees at the three Medium Voltage lines that supply Sporades and the damages have been located at extremely difficult to access areas. The crews of HEDNO remain there and in full alert in order to be attempt access to these location in the early morning hours and proceed with the restoration of the damages.

We would like to remind you that earlier this afternoon, the extreme weather conditions had caused the fall of trees at two of the three Medium Voltage lines in the same area, resulting in the disconnection of supply for the island of Skiathos, which after HEDNO crews hard efforts was restored before the new damage taking place.

HEDNO's entire workforce will continue their non-stop efforts during the evening hours, and wherever there is access, to restore all Network damages that have been caused by the extreme weather system across the country.
