



ANNOUNCEMENT

Following the severe damages that have been caused by the extreme Medea weather system at the Electricity Distribution Network and which resulted in the fall of hundred of trees on Medium and Low Voltage lines in many areas of Attica and mainly the Northern Suburbs, HEDNO would like to announce that currently their technical staff (about 400 workmen) enhanced with 60 more persons from other regions, continue their efforts for the restoration of all problems.

Coordinated crews of HEDNO along with workforce provided by the Municipalities, the Fire Service and Civil Protection as well as the Army, are trying to complete the opening of central and auxiliary roads and the pruning of trees in order to ensure access to all parts of the Network that have been afflicted.

Since the morning of Monday, 15 February and until this hour, the crews of HEDNO in Attica proceeded with cutting and pruning more than 700 trees that had fallen on the Network, mainly at the Northern Suburbs of Attica, having caused damages to at least 85 Medium Voltage (MV) lines. There have been hundreds of fixes at the Medium Voltage network and almost 35 MV lines have been restored in total.

HEDNO will continue restoration works at the Network throughout the evening hours, at all areas that suffer from electricity problems.
